I accept my position in the Banyule & Districts Netball Association Inc. year 2017 Representative Team Squad.

I/We agree to abide by the following commitments:

- At all times abide by the rules and regulations of the Banyule & Districts Netball Association, other Associations we attend and Netball Victoria guidelines and regulations and to be a financial member of Netball Victoria.
- I understand that I am required to play for a registered club or team within a BDNA run competition for the full 12 months I am selected. (Open age players exempt)
- I will pay all fees in relation to playing in the Representative Team within 14 days of receiving the invoice unless arrangements have been made.
- I understand that my court time could be limited if my fees are not paid on time (see Rep Protocols)
- To complete our Pre Season Training program.
- To attend all scheduled training sessions.
- If I am unable to attend a training session I will endeavour to contact my coach prior to the date and inform them of such.
- If I do not attend a training session, I understand that my court time maybe limited at the coaches discretion.
- To be committed to all scheduled games/tournaments for the 2017 season.
- I accept that the selection is for the calendar year of 2017
- To advise coaching staff of any injuries, incurred at training, tournaments or social games.
- To submit a Medical Clearance letter from Medical Practitioner, or relevant Allied Health Professional on any major injuries before training or match play can recommence.
- We acknowledge that our photo could be taken for promotional or advertising purposes by the Association and that our photo could appear on the BDNA official Web Site, our Facebook site, Newsletters or at the Stadium.

I/We understand that playing Representative Netball is a privilege and not a “Right” and that our skill, fitness and attitude will determine our playing court time and movement between teams, and that this will be at our coaches’ discretion and is not negotiable.

I/We acknowledge that by being given the opportunity to represent the Association I must show pride and loyalty and should always put the Association’s best interest first. I agree not to make disparaging comments/remarks, take Legal Action, Media Interviews or anything else that is likely to damage the Association’s reputation in anyway, spread malicious gossip, or attempt to entice others to leave Association clubs or teams.

In accepting this invitation to train and play for BDNA I/we realise that I will not be able to play for any other netball team, club or association that plays in any competition in which Banyule Netball Association competes.
