- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators.
- 2. Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as sexual or other harassment
- 3. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors
- 4. Care and respect the uniform and equipment provided to you
- 5. Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train and play fully
- 6. Conduct yourself in a responsible manner relating to language, temper and punctuality.
- 7. Maintain a high standard of personal behavior at all times
- 8. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the umpires. Be courteous and use the correct process shown seeking a rule clarification.
- 9. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- 10. Cooperate with coaches and staff in relation to programs that adequately prepare you for your competition.
- 11. Do not engage in practices that affect sporting performance (alcohol, tobacco, and drug use).
- 12. Acknowledge that by being given the opportunity to play within the Association Competitions you must show pride and loyalty and should always put the Association's best interest first, and that you respect the association by not making disparaging comments/remarks that are likely to damage the Association's reputation, spread malicious gossip, or attempt to entice others to leave the Association or its clubs or teams.
